ICE is building prisons

The Department of Homeland Security is planning to purchase warehouses in 23 US cities to turn them into jails to kidnap, cage, and disappear people.

Two are planned for GA

The warehouse in Social Circle plans to cage 8500 people at a time, almost double as much as the largest already-existing ICE detention center.

The warehouse in Flowery Branch plans to hold 1500 people.

The new sites would double the amount of people ICE can cage.

Right now there are more than 73,000 people in ICE custody, which is a new record. The new sites would give the agency another 76,500 beds.

The ICE director reported that he envisions these detention centers "like Amazon...but with people."

WHAT YOU CAN DO IF YOU'RE NOT SURE WHERE TO START

1. Ring a friend

Call that friend who's always down and ask them to help you.

2. Host a meeting

On your block, with your friends, family, co-workers. Provide some light snacks. Tell them what's going on. Discuss what you can do about it. Follow up in a week.

3. Plan a canvass

Set up somewhere busy, like before/after a basketball game, on a weekend afternoon downtown, in front of Kroger. Talk to people about the issue. Exchange contact info. Follow up within a week.

4. Call a protest

Make a flyer with a date, time, and place. Send to friends, family, co-workers, and media. Canvass and invite strangers. Bring a megaphone!

5. Get connected

Ask around and check social media to get connected to local immigrant justice orgs, people's assemblies, and other anti-ICE spaces.

Georgia is already number 4 in states with the highest deportations.

And is home to several detention centers, all of which have seen preventable deaths, sexual and physical abuse, medical neglect, and more human rights violations.

These warehouse prisons could be built in 60 days

A Navy software named TITUS allows ICE to connect with military contractors and start construction immediately.

The government wants to deport 1 million people a year.

In order to do this they will need to find people by going into their communities and neighborhoods. This means they will come for our neighbors.

3,000 ICE agents were deployed in Minneapolis. Do we want that in our town?
